The George & Dragon has 10 comfortable bedrooms all with en-suite facilities. All the rooms have colour television and free tea and coffee making facilities.

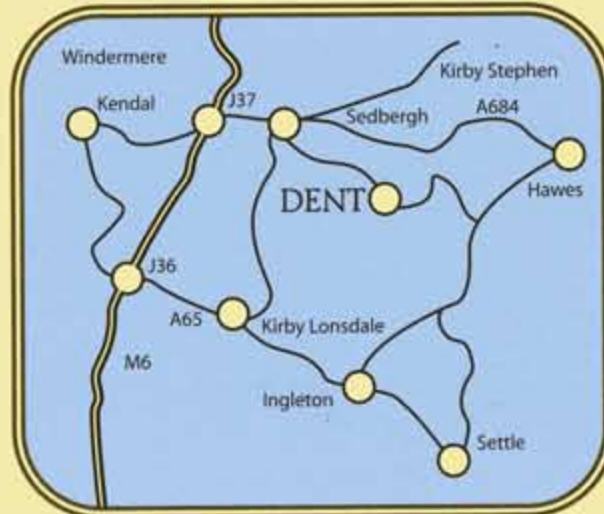


## Dent Village

## The Brewery

Nestling in picturesque Dentdale, The George & Dragon is a Dent Brewery house.

Founded in 1990, Dent Brewery is one of the most remote breweries in the country, situated in a scenic corner of the Yorkshire Dales National Park that is actually in Cumbria.

Visitors to the Dales enjoyed our ales so much that they persuaded licensees in their home towns to obtain a cask or two as a "guest beer". As a result draught Dent beer has been known to travel as far as Jersey in the Channel Islands and is regularly on sale in good pubs all over the North. Our bottled beers are enjoyed as far away as South America and Australia but can also be found nearer to home.



Dent beers, created by head brewer Paul Goodyear using the natural spring water that bubbles out of Rise Hill, have now become so famous that people come to sample them not only from all over Britain, but also on specially organised trips from as far afield as the USA and Japan.
